NOTICE is also given that on the 25 July 2011 at 10.00am and thereafter until the conclusion of the audit, the auditor at the request of a local government elector for any area to which the accounts relate, will give the elector or his representative an opportunity to question him about the accounts, and that any such elector or his representative may attend before the auditor and make objections as to any matter in respect of which the auditor can take action under Sections 17 and 18 of the Audit Commission Act 1998:-

- Any item of account which is alleged to be contrary to the law
- Particulars of any matter in respect of which it is proposed that the auditor could make a report under section 8 of that Act
