Travel Advice

As a passenger, we ask that you do the following:

- Arrive at the bus stop at least 5 minutes before your bus is due to leave.
- Allow 20 minutes for your bus to arrive before registering a complaint.
- Signal clearly to the driver whenever you wish to board or alight.
- Have concessions ready to display when you board and ensure that you have all personal items with you before leaving the vehicle.

Bank Holiday Services

The usual schedule is that buses operate as normal on Good Friday and operate a Sunday timetable on all other Bank Holidays with the exception of Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Years Day, when there are NO services operating.
