- (f) If the property is empty that date it became empty
- (g) Please also state which hereditament is currently receiving
 - I. Charitable rate relief (mandatory rate relief)
 - II. Discretionary rate relief
 - III. Empty property rate relief
 - IV. Listed building exemption
 - V. Retail Relief
 - VI Small Business Rate Relief
 - VII. Any other relief
- (h) List of all credits on account and the amounts
