

NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

GREETHAM NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN AREA

REFERENDUM ON THE ADOPTION OF THE GREETHAM NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

1. A referendum is to be held on **Thursday, 7th September 2017** to decide on the question below:

'Do you want Rutland County Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Greetham to help it decide planning applications in the Neighbourhood Area?'

2. Applications to be included on the register of electors for this referendum must be received no later than 12 midnight on Monday **21st August 2017**. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
3. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal or postal proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at RUTLAND COUNTY COUNCIL, CATMOSE, OAKHAM, LE15 6HP by 5pm on Tuesday **22nd August 2017**, if they are to be effective for this referendum.
4. Applications to vote by proxy except on the grounds of a medical emergency must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at RUTLAND COUNTY COUNCIL, CATMOSE, OAKHAM, LE15 6HP by 5pm on Wednesday **30th August 2017**, if they are to be effective for this referendum.
5. Applications to vote by proxy on the grounds of a physical incapacity or for work / service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at RUTLAND COUNTY COUNCIL, CATMOSE, OAKHAM by 5 pm on Polling Day. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday **30 August 2017**. To apply on the grounds of work / service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday **30 August 2017**.
