

Rutland County Council Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL)

Regulation 62 CIL Monitoring Report 2018/19 – Published December 2019

Introduction

The Rutland County Council CIL Charging Schedule came into effect on 1 March 2016. Regulation 62 of the CIL regulations (as amended) requires a Charging Authority to prepare a report for any financial year (“the reported year”).

The report must include:

- a) The total CIL receipts for the reported year
- b) The total CIL expenditure for the reported year
- c) Summary details of CIL expenditure during the reported year
- d) The total amount of CIL receipts retained at the end of the reported year
- e) Any infrastructure payments accepted by the Charging Authority
