

## **Rutland County Council**

### **Town & Country Planning Act 1990 Neighbourhood Planning Regulations (General) Regulations 2012**

Rutland County Council received from Uppingham Town Council an application to designate the whole of Uppingham Parish, along with parts of Ayston Parish on the northern edge of Uppingham adjacent and to the south of the A47, as a neighbourhood area for preparing a neighbourhood plan.
