

**Rutland County Council
Local Development Framework
Minerals Core Strategy and Development Control Policies**

Adoption Statement

The Minerals Core Strategy and Development Control Policies Development Plan Document (Minerals DPD) was adopted by Rutland County Council on the 11th October 2010. It sets out the vision, objectives, spatial strategy, policies and development control policies to guide minerals development in Rutland up to 2026 and forms part of the Local Development Framework for Rutland.

The Minerals DPD was considered by an independent Inspector at a Public Examination held between 20th – 22nd April 2010. The Inspector's Report was published on the 15th June 2010 and can be viewed at the locations below and on the Council's website www.rutland.gov.uk/mineralscorestrategy. The adopted Core Strategy incorporates the binding recommendations of the Inspector.

Any person aggrieved by the Minerals DPD may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:

- a) the document is not within the appropriate power
- b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with

An application under Section 113 must be made no later than the end of the period of six weeks of the date of the adoption of the Core Strategy starting from the 11th October 2010.
