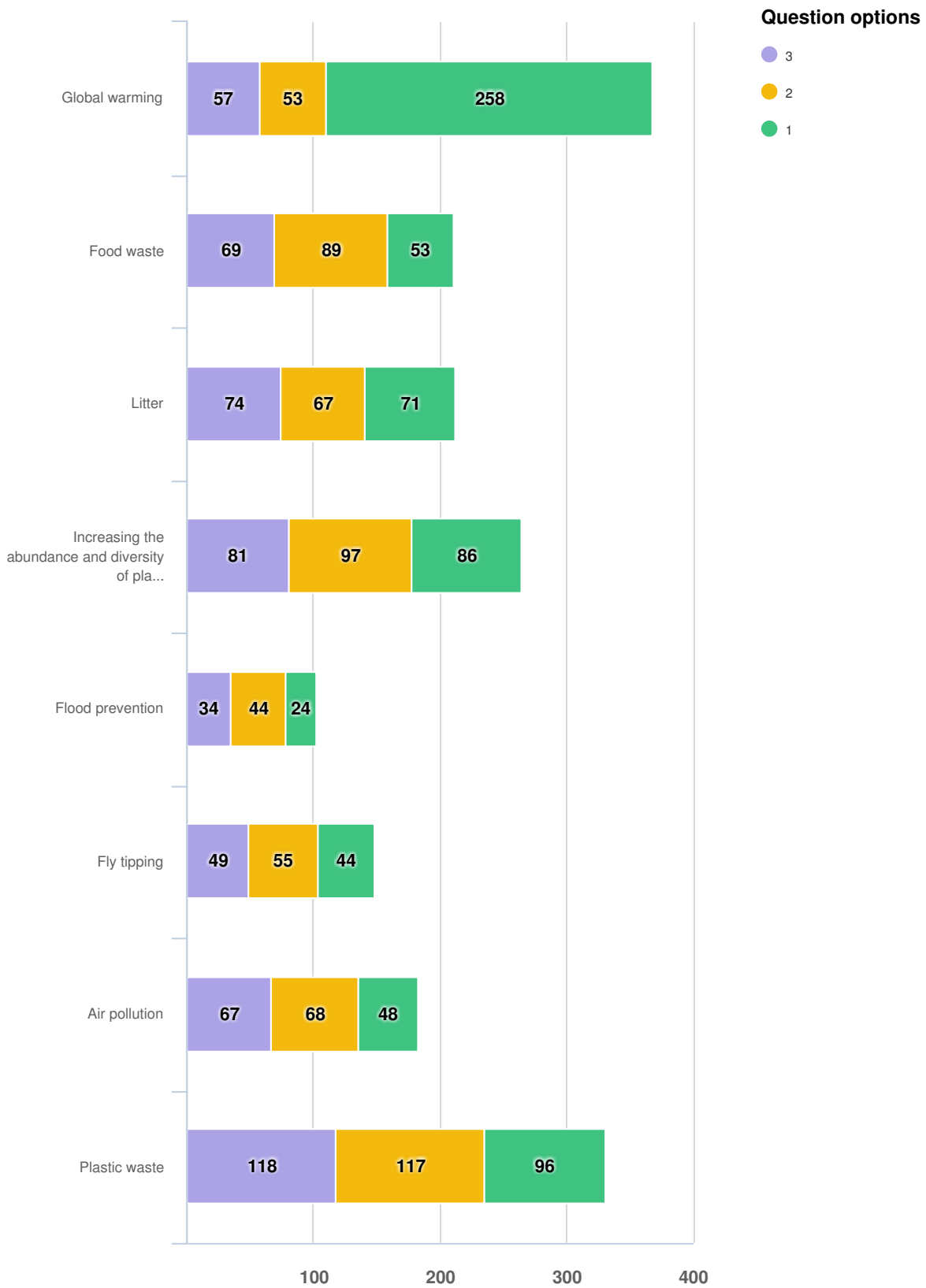

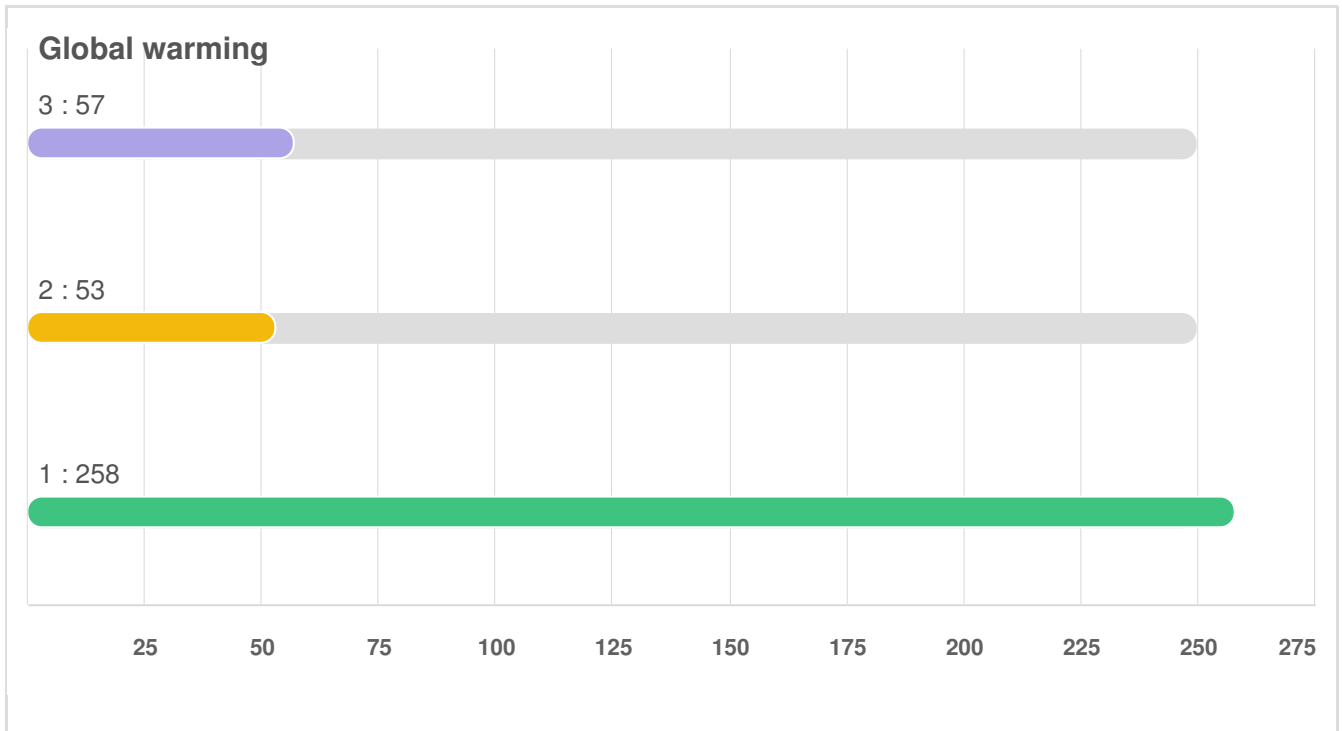

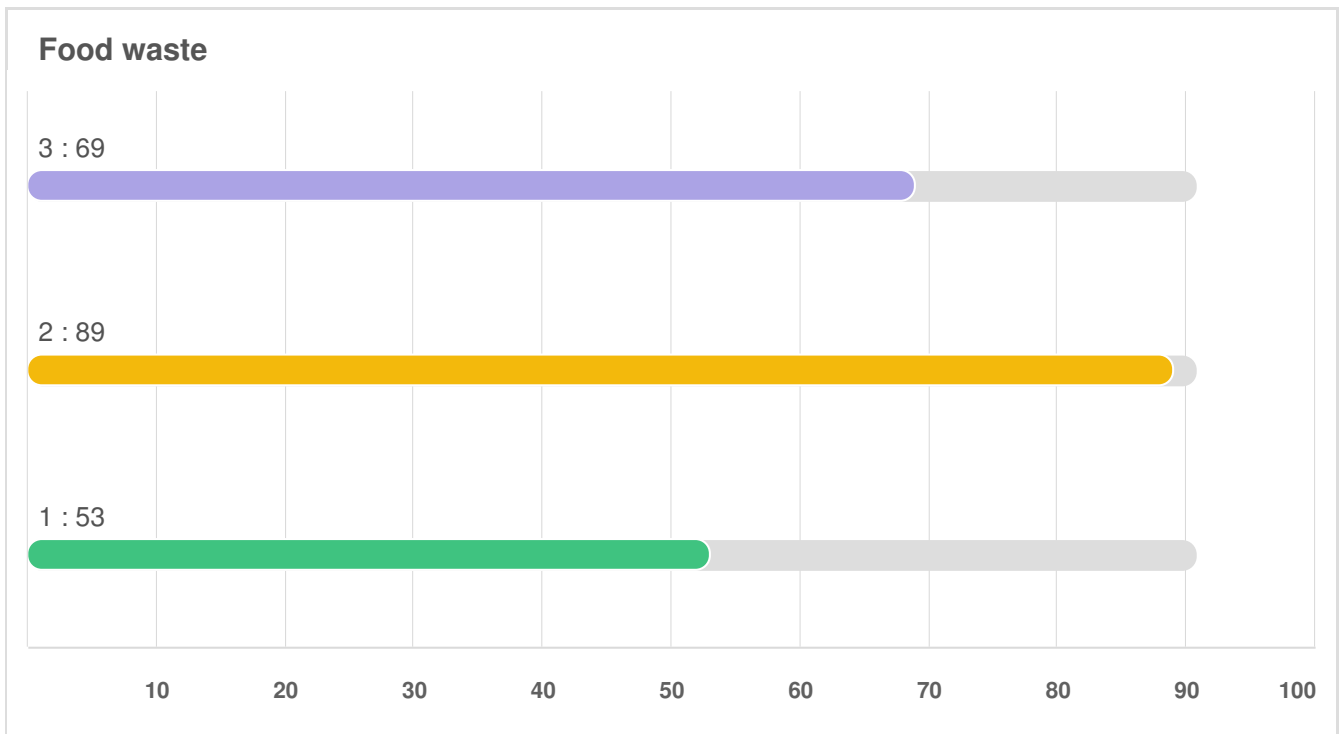
Q1 Which three aspects of the environment do you feel need addressing most urgently?

Q3 Are you aware that Rutland County Council has declared a climate crisis?



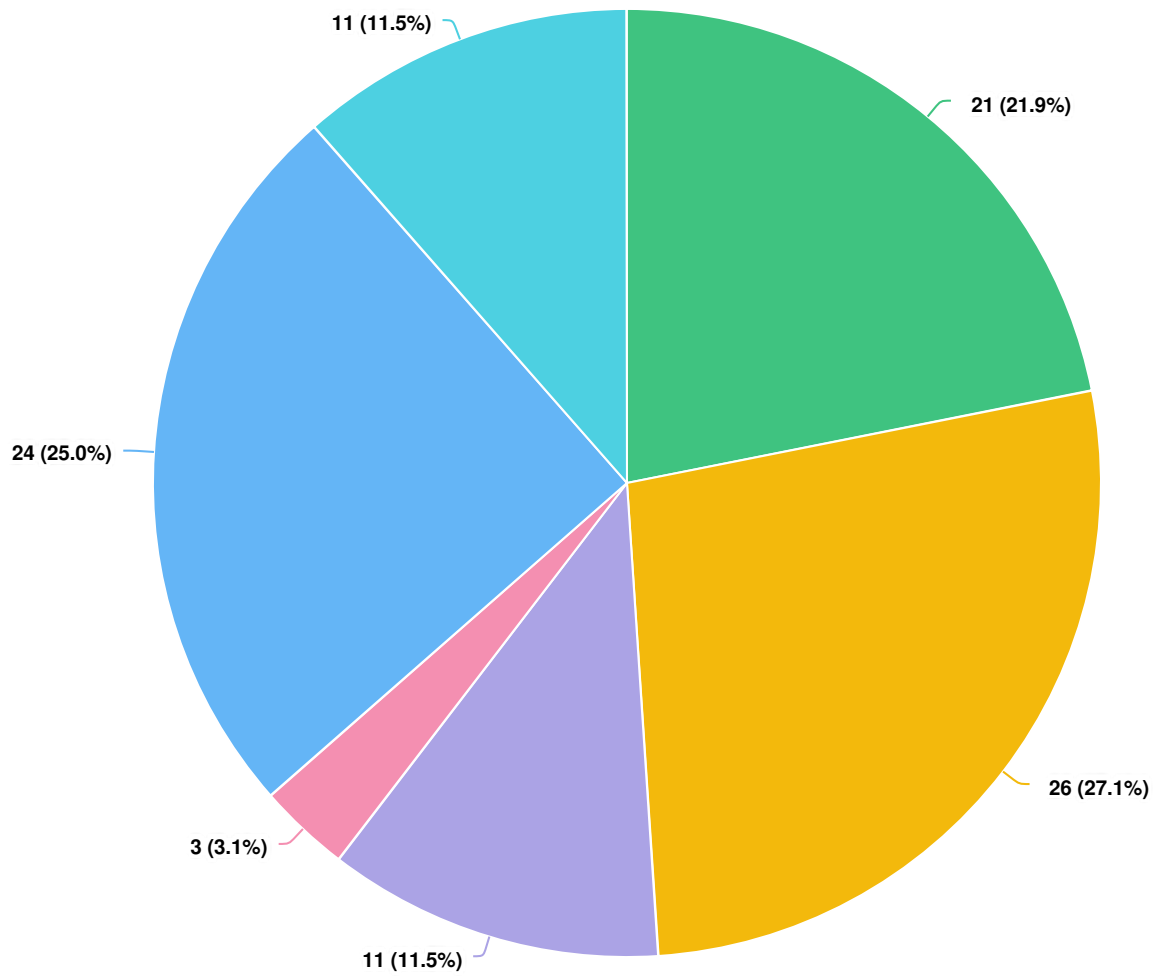

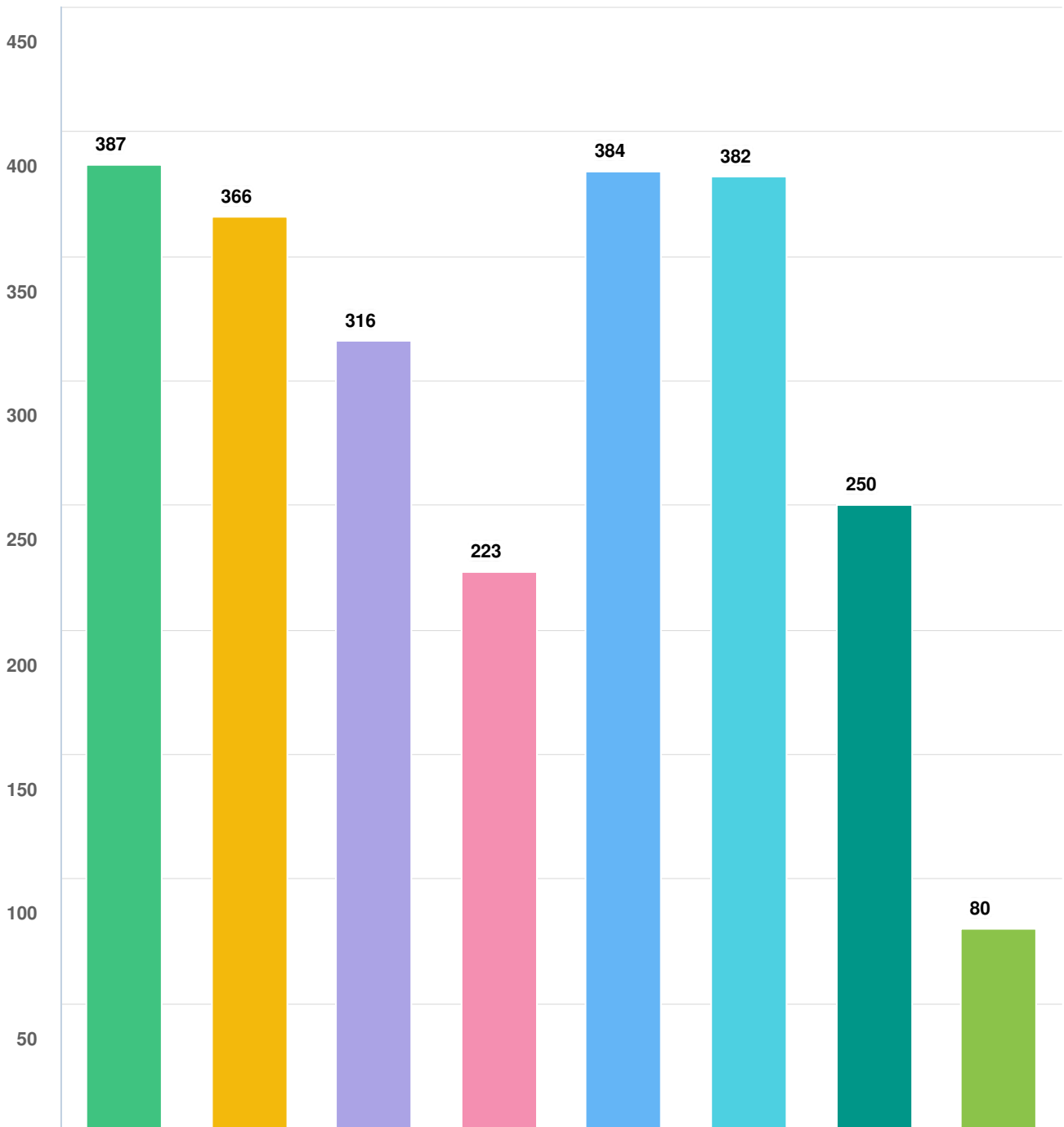

Q5 What do you think a sustainable Rutland should include in the future? (Select all that apply)

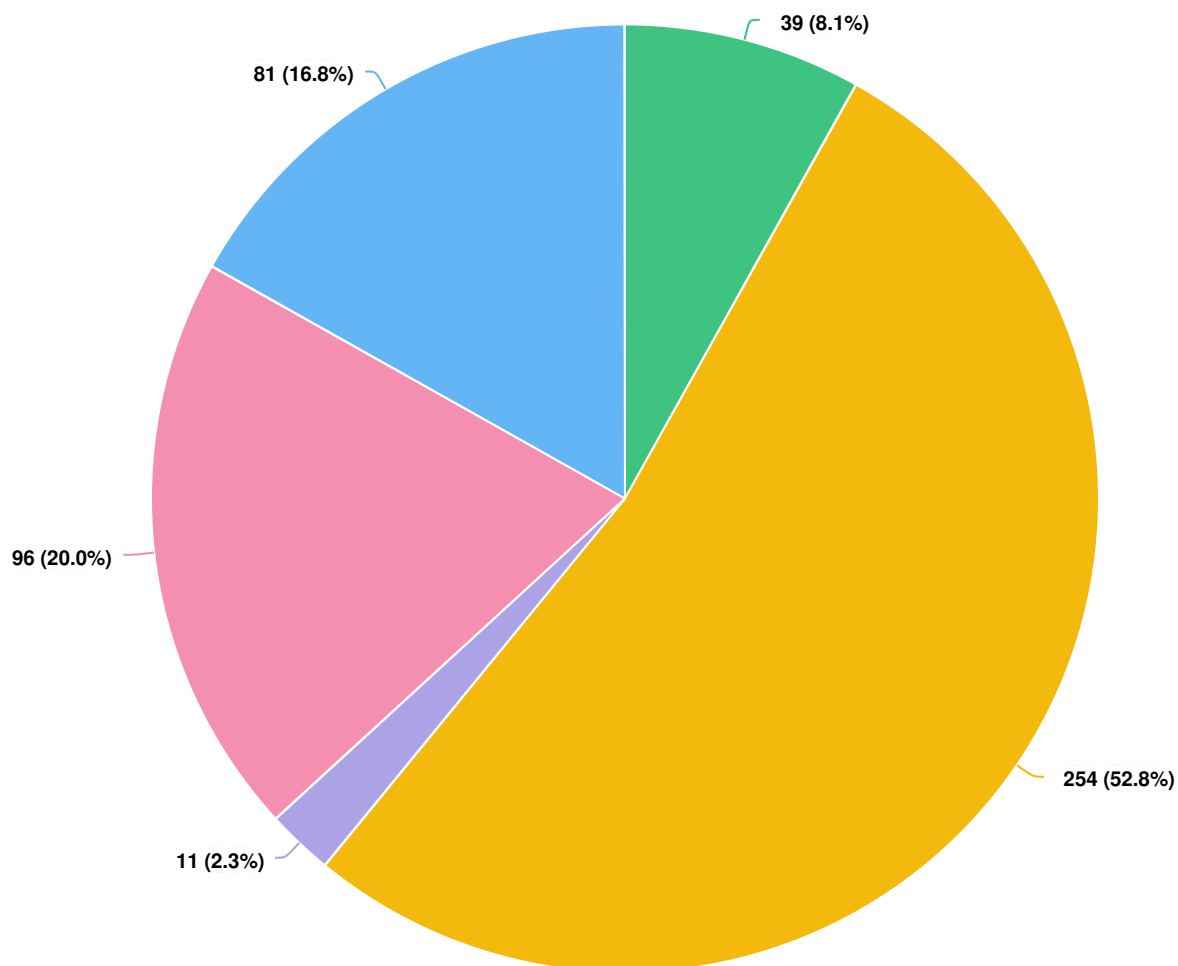

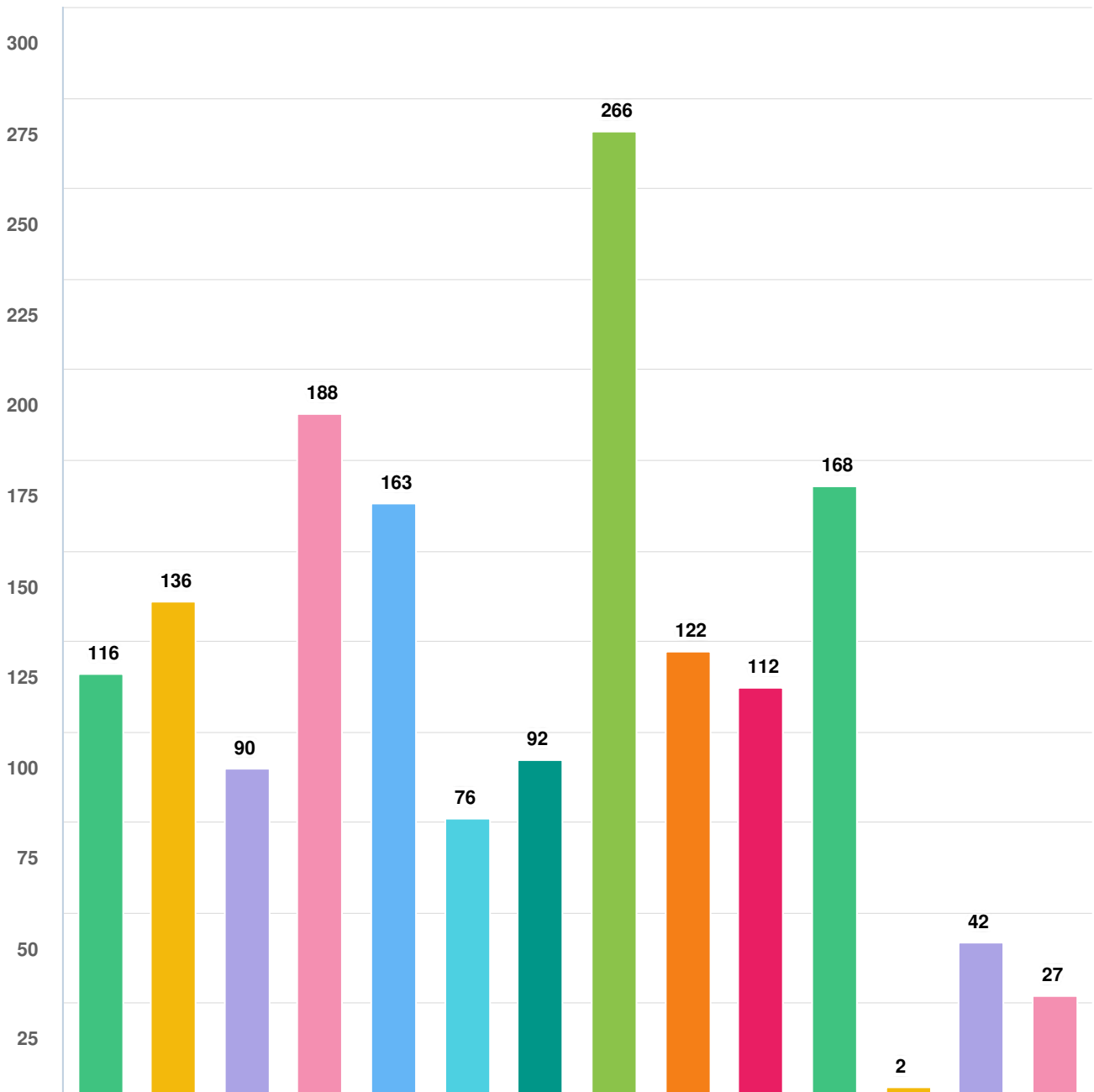
