

Housing Grants, Construction and Regeneration Act 1996 Regulatory Reform (Housing Assistance) (England and Wales) Order 2002

Notice is hereby given under article 4 of the Regulatory Reform (Housing Assistance) (England and Wales) Order 2002 that Rutland County Council has adopted the Private Sector Housing Renewal Policy 2021-25 version 1.00 for the provision of assistance under article 3 of the same Order. This policy will come into force on 1 April 2021.

The Private Sector Housing Renewal Policy covers:

- the condition of the housing stock in Rutland and the need for any improvements
- the grants that the Council can provide towards some of these improvements for eligible applicants and the conditions attached to those grants
- the advice available to applicants.

This includes help towards the cost of adaptations for both private sector and housing association properties for eligible applicants.
