Subsidiary Terms and Conditions
Attached to Street Trading Licence

1. The name and address of the person to whom this licence is granted shall be legibly and conspicuously displayed on the stall, unit, vehicle, or container.
2. The licence holder shall:-
 - a. Provide suitable toilet facilities for use by the licence holder, their staff, and customers.
 - b. Not place or deposit any refuse or waste arising from the business anywhere other than in a receptacle provided for that purpose. With respect to refuse and waste storage facilities, please refer to condition 4 below.
 - c. To maintain and operate their business to which the licence relates in such a manner as to comply with all the relevant provisions contained in the Food Safety Act 1990 and the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974.
 - d. Permit any person duly authorised by the Council to:
 - i. Inspect the premises to which the licence relates.
 - ii. Inspect any records required by relevant legislation, including records kept by the licence holder in pursuance of a due diligence defence.
 - iii. Take samples for bacteriological or other testing.

3. Where the licence is revoked for any reason or surrendered by the licence-holder, the licence-holder shall remove any stall, unit, vehicle or container belonging to him/her from the street within 7 days.

If the stall, unit, vehicle or container belonging to the licence-holder is not removed from the relevant lay-by within 7 days the Council may remove the said item from the site and recover from the owner such reasonable charges as they may determine for the removal of the said Item.

4. The licence-holder is responsible for the security of the receptacle provided by the Council. If the licence holder has failed to secure that container against theft or has negligently failed to protect the container against damage or has caused any damage to the container which prevents its continued use, other than defects which may occur through reasonable wear and tear, he shall be charged for its replacement.
5. The waste receptacle provided by the Council shall be cleaned twice yearly by the Council's Contractor. The receptacle must be made available by the licence holder when requested to enable cleaning to be undertaken.
6. Should the licence holder dispose of his/her business, the Council (Environmental Services Department) should be notified immediately in writing. A licence is not transferable to the new owner.

7. Payment of licence fee and service charges

The licence shall only become valid only where a valid application and the full licence fee has been paid to the Council. Where a licence is voluntarily surrendered by the licensee, no part of the licence fee shall be refunded.

The Council will also require the payment of a service charge for the weekly collection of refuse and regular de-littering of the licensed area. The service charge shall be payable in arrears by prior arrangement with the Council. Any outstanding service charge fees must be paid prior to the renewal of a licence or prior to the issue of a licence to the new owner should the business be sold.
